**WASHINGTON, D.C.** (June 8, 2023) – <u>The National Independent Venue Association (NIVA)</u> will bring the independent live concert, comedy, promoter, and festival industry together for its second annual national gathering in Washington, D.C. at **NIVA '23**, July 9 - 12. The conference will shine a light on NIVA's 26 D.C. members, with conference programming to take place across



12 venues throughout the city, including 9:30 Club, The Anthem, The Atlantis, Black Cat,, Capital Turnaround, DC9 Nightclub, DC Improv, Pearl Street Warehouse, Pie Shop, The Pocket, Songbyrd, and Union Stage. NIVA '23 is open to the public. To register go to nivassoc.org/conference.

As the conference converges on Washington, D.C. attendees of NIVA '23 can expect sessions in marketing, industry diversity, mental health, safety, insurance, economic impact of live entertainment, booking, artist development, ticketing, and the role of live entertainment in policymaking. The conference will highlight NIVA's local members – in addition to renowned local artist, Jeffrey Everett, who designed the program art.

Washington, D.C. Mayor Muriel Bowser will kick off NIVA '23 with a welcome Monday morning, July 10, followed by a full slate of programming. Sessions will include *Leveraging Social Media Marketing Tools to Pack Shows* led by representatives from Meta and Tik Tok, *Building Brand Halo: How Independent Venues and Festivals Build Communities, Breaking Down the Walls: Advocating Together for the Future of Entertainment & the Arts, Building An Equitable Industry - Lessons from Changemakers, How Festivals Are Incubators for Live Industry Innovation, Protecting Venues and Festivals: Safety Against Evolving Threats, and more.* 

In addition to sessions, workshops and networking, there will be live music performances nightly featuring the Official Opening Party presented by See Tickets on Sunday, July 9 at 9:30 Club and The Atlantis, Salute to Small Venues presented by TIDAL on Tuesday, July 11, and the NIVA '23 Closing Party sponsored by Dice at Black Cat on Wednesday, July 12, with daytime conference programming taking place Monday, July 10 at The Anthem and Union Stage and Tuesday, July 11 at Capital Turnaround.

NIVA '23 Independent Awards Gala will take place at The Anthem on Monday, July 10. The Awards ceremony will honor those who have done outstanding work to further NIVA's mission to preserve and nurture the community of independent live entertainment.
